Mr. Hunt is the Assistant Division Director heading the Office of Consumer Finance (“OCF”) within the Division of Banking of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance, and is responsible for examining credit unions and non-depository financial institutions, enforcing consumer protection regulations, and handling the Department’s licensure of thousands of companies and individuals working in that area. He has been active with multi-state regulator groups. The OCF regulates more than 3,000 non-depository entities of 15 different types operating in New Jersey such as mortgage lenders, consumer lenders, sales finance companies, check cashers, money transmitters, and pawnbrokers. The unit coordinates with federal agencies, regulators in other States, the New Jersey Attorney General’s Office, and various other law enforcement agencies. Mr. Hunt is currently Vice Chair of the Board of the State’s Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency. He was a Deputy Attorney General for 15 years with the Division of Law at the State Attorney General’s Office. He holds a JD from Rutgers School of Law, Newark, an MA from Cambridge University, and an AB from Princeton University. Mr. Hunt has been a trustee and officer for several non-profit institutions.
